**Mountain Electric Coopera-  
tive - TVA & MEC Major  
Power Outage Postponed!**  
The power outage scheduled  
for **Saturday night, October  
27th has been postponed  
until 11:30 p.m. Saturday  
night, November 10, 2018.**  
The outage will impact  
14,500 customers over much  
of Avery County including the  
following communities: New-  
land, Cranberry, Minneapolis,  
Banner Elk, Sugar Mountain,  
Grandfather, Montezuma,

Linville, Pineola, Crossnore,  
Jonas Ridge and Linville Falls.  
The outage is necessary to  
replace and/or repair TVA/  
MEC high-voltage equipment  
at the Cranberry Substation.  
Work should be completed,  
and power restored by 8:30  
a.m. Sunday Morning.
