**Because of the continuing generosity of the congregation, our church has distributed another \$5,450 to local non-profits that are assisting those in need.** Since April, we have dispensed over \$20,000 to our partner non-profits in Avery

County. We also have sent \$1,000 to our sister church, El Libano Presbyterian Church, in Los Cerros, Guatemala, to provide food supplies to 50 struggling families in that village. The \$5,450 from the Pastor's Discretionary Fund and the Mission Fund have been given this month to the following local agencies: Feeding Avery Families- \$1,500; Volunteer Avery County-\$800; Reaching Avery Ministry- \$500; WAMY- \$1,350; Mountain Alliance- \$800; and Yellow Mountain Enterprises-\$500. Each non-profit agency was contacted for an update on their work and their needs before the funds were allocated. **Thank you for your faithful and generous offerings to the General Fund and the Pastor's Discretionary Fund. We are blessed to be able to contribute to those in need and pay our bills.** May God so inspire us that we will be able to do the same in the month ahead. Please know that the Session and staff continue to be wise stewards for every dollar received.

733-2025.

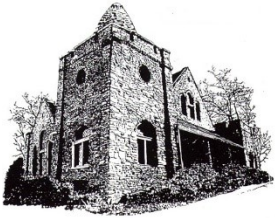
**Our Friday Hands-On Service Project is with Feeding Avery Families that provides over 600 families and individuals each month with much need groceries.** Volunteers are

The church's sanctuary roof committee continues to make plans to go forward with the replacement of our nearly 100 year old sanctuary roof. In the August 26 Midweek News we shared pictures and information about the complete laser scan of the sanctuary building. The image below shows the sanctuary front. While this image appears to be a photo taken with a stone aged digital camera, each pixel is a data point that contains distance and angle information the computer uses to build the three dimensional model. Next week, looking into the interior.
