If you don't feel safe coming inside, you can stay in your car in the parking lot and listen on 87.7 FM radio OR live on Zoom at 11 a.m. You can also share in the virtual service that will be sent out by 11 a.m. on Sunday morning. We are also taping the worship service and will include the link to the recorded service in our Midweek News on Wednesday.



You can join us for live at 11:00 am through a Zoom link. If you have never used Zoom on your computer, phone or other internet connected device, Zoom will automatically download when you click the link and you will just follow the prompts.

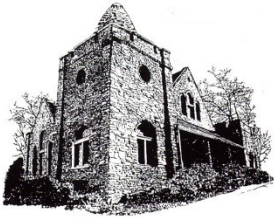
#### COVID-19 Thanksgiving Precautions:

If you are planning to visit family or friends during Thanksgiving, it is suggested that you quarantine

10 days and have a negative test. If you are visiting a younger, healthy family member and have little chance of being exposed before or during travel, then 5 or 7 days (of quarantine) plus a negative test is probably plenty of risk reduction, though no guarantee of safety. Either way, you should definitely remain in quarantine while awaiting test results and make sure everyone you are getting together with is on the same page about the plan for controlling infection risk."

**We will be meeting in the sanctuary for Sunday worship. Our church COVID-19 Committee is making sure that we are following the federal and state guidelines:** limiting the length of the service, 10 feet social distancing

upon entering and sitting in the pew and leaving, everyone wearing masks, Pastor Kathy and one liturgist will be sharing all the spoken parts of worship, the hymns will be played on the piano/organ, no singing, bulletins placed in the pews by Thursday to prevent hand to hand contact, and offering plates will be placed in the front and back of the sanctuary. The sanctuary will be heated in advance and the furnace will be turned off during worship to prevent stale airflow, the windows will be cracked with the ceiling fans turned on. If you wish to come to the church, not come in but stay in your car, the service will be broadcast in the parking lot on 87.7 FM radio.
