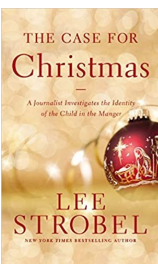

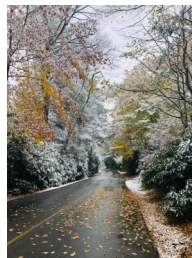

Strobel. In these days when truth is of paramount importance in our country, this Bible study reflects the need for truth, then faith, with these questions so many non-believers ask: What does the Bible actually say about Jesus' birth and is it accurate? Did the Christmas story truly occur or just developed from legends? Why does the Bible claim that Jesus was born to a virgin and why is it im-
