"Senator Sam Ervin: The Humor of a Country Lawyer" will be presented by Dr. Karl Campbell, Professor of History, Appalachian State University as the first of our 2022 Summer Series of Speakers and Music. "An ounce of revealing humor," wrote Senator Ervin, "has more power to reveal, convince, or ridicule than do many tomes of erudite argument." In the 1970s, Americans watched the Bible-quoting "old country lawyer" from Morganton put his mountain stories to good use as he led the Senate investigation of the Wa-



tergate Scandal. Dr. Karl Campbell, Ervin's biographer, will discuss the Senator's historical legacy while reminding us of the importance of humor, and civility, in our contemporary political debates. All Summer Series events are free and open to the public.
