Choir will practice at 9:30 a.m. on Sunday in the fellowship hall. If you would like to join the choir, we would love to have you.



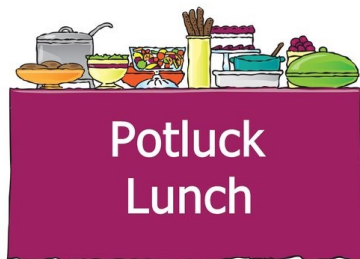
A note from Gene Hodges: "We might have slippery roads this Sunday. The front driveway gets icy quickly in bad weather."

Please use the back drive entrance anytime we have ice or snow, it is much safer."

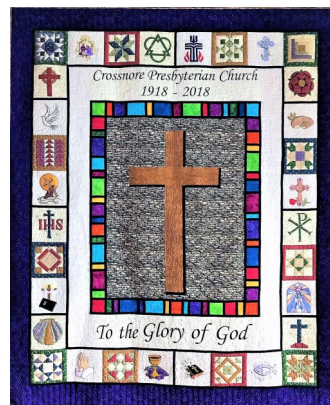
Last Sunday's musical worship serve was beautiful. Thank you to everyone who shared their musical talents with us.
