Checks should be made out to Crossnore Presbyterian Church and designated for Guatemala. We received a notebook with all the photos of the students, their grade levels from kindergarten to graduate

school, the career they hope to have one day, and every receipt from every purchase that was made for each student! This continues to be an investment in God’s future for these students and for their community.
